4 **Counting Every Citizen**

5 In recent decades, India has been experiencing very rapid economic growth.
 6 Yet, while the country as a whole has grown much wealthier, it still has more
 7 poor people than any other country in the world.

8 It is difficult to say exactly how many poor people there are in India, but many
 9 experts agree that around a third of the population suffers from poverty.
 10 Although the Indian government has many programs designed to help these
 11 people, many people still do not receive the financial support they need.
 12 The national government believes one reason is that local officials sometimes
 13 steal this money. In order to solve this problem, the national government started
 14 a program in 2010 with the aim of using new technology to help the poor.

20 This program is known as the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI).
 21 This is a project to record the identity of every Indian individual in a huge
 22 government database. The government records the name, date of birth, address,
 23 and fingerprints of each person. Each person is then given a number. By 2018,
 24 93 percent of the population had been recorded in this way. It is hoped that the
 25 UIDAI will allow individuals to deal directly with the national government
 26 rather than going through local officials. For example, the government gives
 27 money to people with less than a certain income. This money is now paid
 28 directly into individuals' bank accounts, rather than through local offices.
 29 The system also allows people to prove who they are, so they are able to obtain
 30 education, drivers' licenses, and other government services.

 42 government services. In addition, some machines designed to check the identity
 43 of individuals do not work properly. However, the Indian government is confident
 44 that it will solve these problems before long, and the UIDAI will be a success.
